## Our New Ministry!

A Different Organization?

Yes, the Days have begun a new ministry. Gregg will now be able to do more work overseas than he was with Zeal, and will still keep his ministry focused on church planting, leadership training and community development. Why, then, the organization change? Zeal is a ministry

aimed at Muslim people groups. Although this is a people group that needs help and training, because of the culture it is best suited for those who are natives to that culture. Also, Zeal did not provide Gregg with the opportunity to use his gifts and abilities as stated

from the onset of Zeal, which led to the decision to form *His Days of Grace*, a 501(c) (3) non-profit organization. What does this mean? It means that Gregg will be able to again travel, teach, and train rather than focus on administration.

*His Days of Grace (HDG)* has been carefully formed with a board that has seen the need for this ministry and has spent months in prayer and in the work of writing a business plan as they have worked with Gregg and others. The board and the Day’s church will be their accountability partners in finances, focus, and

mission. Gregg’s first trip will be to Q-bah with a team on Nov. 30 –Dec. 9. Next, Gregg will be going to Kenya, partnering with Mission Aviation Fellowship in January. Gregg will be able to use his gifts and abilities to do the work that God has given him to do. It means we can position ourselves to

get out of the way of God so that He can use us to minister. Where does this leave Zeal? Gregg is working with its leadership to make an easy transition into HDG. Zeal will continue with the Muslims. Gregg will continue serving as a Board Member.

## Big Plans Ahead

By God’s grace and your help, His Days of Grace will accomplish four projects over the next 10 years.

1. Provide leadership training, including pastoral training, counseling, and organizational development for the rural church in **Kenya**.

2. Provide the same for the rural church in **Liberia**.

3. Continue to follow up the rural church in **Q-bah** in providing leadership direction and accountability.

4. Work with the Liberians in the refugee camp in

**Ghana** who would like to go back to the cities in Liberia after they have received further theological and practical training.
